JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to pay an appropriate amount of compensation on account of death of his son due to attack by stray dogs.

2. As per petition, the petitioner's son who was 11 years' old died due to attack by stray dogs while playing outside his house. In this regard DDR No.11 dated 03.02.2025 was registered at Police Station Gharaunda. Post-mortem report dated 03.02.2025 details injuries and cause of death. The petitioner is entitled to compensation as per judgment of this Court in ***Rajwinder Kaur v. State of Haryana 2024 (1) R.C.R. (Civil) 775***. The petitioner has filed representation dated 13.05.2025 before Deputy Commissioner, Karnal.

3. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner is supposed to file online application. If he files online application as per Deen Dayal

Upadhyaya Antyodaya Parivar Suraksha Yojna (Dayalu-II) (for short 'Yojna'), his application would be considered in accordance with the Yojna.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file online application as per aforesaid Yojna within one month from today. If the application is filed within aforesaid period, it would be considered and adjudicated by committee within two months from the date of its filing.
