1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.84/2024 registered at Police Station Bicchiwal, District Bikaner for offence under Sections 8/22, 20, 29 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that it is the co-accused Aakash @ Rinku, from whose conscious possession contraband weighing 4.14 grams MDMA & 20.26 grams *Charas*, which are below the commercial quantity, have been recovered. He again submitted that the co-accused Aakash @ Rinku has been enlarged on bail by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 25.07.2024. Though, eight criminal antecedents have

been registered against the petitioner, out of which, one case is of similar nature, but in all the cases, he has already been bailed out. The petitioner is behind the bars since 30.09.2025 and charge-sheet has been filed. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed on the ground of parity.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, especially on the ground of parity with that of the co-accused Aakash @ Rinku, who has already been enlarged on bail, but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Praveen S/o Kala Ram @ Jasmer**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
