Order

1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging disobedience of order dated 14.08.2023 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.3611/2014.
2. Vide order dated 14.08.2023, the Court directed as under:

"23. The writ petition is, therefore, allowed; impugned order dated 26.04.2014 is hereby set aside.

24. The respondent No.5 – the Registrar, Agricultural University, Jodhpur is directed to pass an order of regularization of the petitioner on the post of Programme Assistant (Technical Assistant) notionally with effect from the date when he had filed the writ petition being S. B. Civil Writ Petition No.3090/2006.

25. The petitioner shall be entitled for actual monetary benefits from 26.04.2014, the date on which his representation was rejected. Necessary administrative order be passed within a period of two months from today and the amount consequent to order instant be paid latest by 31st December, 2023."

3. Vide order dated 20.11.2025 (Annex.A/2), the services of the petitioner were regularised w.e.f. 19.06.2006 i.e. the date of filing of the writ petition. Vide the same order, the actual monetary benefits were directed to be granted w.e.f. 26.04.2014.

4. In compliance of order dated 11.02.2026 passed by this Court, an additional affidavit has been filed whereby it has been averred that as directed vide order dated 11.02.2026, the complete amount of Rs. 52,02,823/- after deduction of an amount of Rs. 49,056/- qua the period the petitioner was on leave without pay, has been paid to the petitioner.

5. In view of the above facts, the petitioner's services having been regularised w.e.f. the date of filing of the writ petition and the monetary benefits having been paid to him w.e.f. 26.04.2014, the date as directed vide order dated 14.08.2023, this Court is of the clear opinion that the order has been complied with in its true letter and spirit.

6. So far as the deduction of the amount of Rs. 49,056/- is concerned, the petitioner definitely would be at liberty to assail the same, if aggrieved.

7. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to proceed with the present contempt proceedings any further. The present contempt petition hence, stands **disposed of**.

8. Rule stands discharged.
