1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and upon prima facie consideration of the order dated 07.01.2026 passed by the

District Collector, Barmer, this Court is of the opinion that once the notification dated 28.12.2025 was issued and published in the Official Gazette on 31.12.2025, it attains the character of subordinate legislation. Consequently, the same cannot be reviewed, modified or re-examined by the District Collector, Barmer in exercise of administrative powers. The constitution of a committee by the District Collector, Barmer, vide order dated 07.01.2026, to examine grievances relating to the establishment of the headquarters of the newly constituted Gram Panchayat Bhursingh Ki Dhani, therefore, prima facie appears to be without jurisdiction and to be illegal.

3. In view of the above, issue notice to the respondents.

4. Mr. I.R. Choudhary, learned Additional Advocate General, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Service is, therefore, complete.

5. In the meanwhile and until the next date of hearing, the effect and operation of the order dated 07.01.2026 (Annexure-4) passed by the District Collector, Barmer shall remain stayed.

6. It is made clear that this order shall not preclude the respondents from filing an appropriate application seeking vacation of the present interim order along with their reply.
