The present letter petition has been filed by the convict-petitioner for releasing him on emergent parole on the ground that petitioner's wife was pregnant and there is nobody in the family to look after the well-being of his wife. It is therefore, prayed that the petitioner-convict may be enlarged on emergent parole for a period of fifteen days.

3. A reply has been filed by the State Government that the petitioner had undergone a total incarceration of about twelve years and five months and then availed parole on seven occasions. The conduct of the petitioner during the parole period as well as in the jail, is found satisfactory. It is further stated that petitioner's wife had delivered on 13.12.2025.

4. In these circumstances, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on parole for a period of ten days.

5. Accordingly, the present petition for grant of emergent parole is allowed.

6. The petitioner shall be released on emergent parole for 10 days on his furnishing personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of concerned Jail Authority. The concerned Jail Authority shall be at liberty to impose other adequate and reasonable conditions to ensure return of the convict to the prison after availing the parole. The term of parole shall be computed from the date of his actual release.
