**Order**

1. These applications for bail have been filed by the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS (old Section 439 of Cr.P.C.). The requisite details of the matters are tabulated herein below:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the case and false allegations have been levelled against them. The investigation has been completed. The petitioners were arrested merely on apprehension that they are involved in sale and purchase of illegal arms. No recovery is to be made from the present petitioners. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 30.11.2025 and the trial will take sufficiently long time, therefore, they deserve to be enlarged on bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes these bail applications and submits that investigation is concluded and prima facie offence against the present petitioners is made out, therefore, the petitioners may not be enlarged on bail.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

5. Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of this case and after perusing the case diary so also the fact that investigation has been concluded and no recovery is to be made from them and that the petitioners are in judicial custody since 30.11.2025, in the considered opinion of this Court, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the

petitioners behind the bars for an indefinite period as the trial will take sufficiently long time. Thus, without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that these bail applications filed by the petitioners deserve to be accepted.

6. Accordingly, these bail applications filed under Section 483 of BNSS are allowed. It is ordered that petitioners- **Goutam S/o Narendra Kumar, Kamendra Singh @ Rahul S/o Gopal Singh Gehlot** and **Aditya Puri Goswami Alias Anshu S/o Ramesh Puri Goswami**, shall be released on bail in connection with the aforesaid FIR; provided they execute personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court for their appearance before that court on each and every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till the completion of the trial.

7. It is however, made clear that findings recorded/observations made above are for limited purposes of adjudication of bail application. The trial court shall not get prejudiced by the same.
