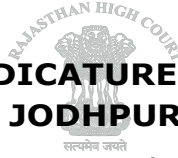

1. The order-sheet dated 15.01.2026 reflects that this Court had directed the Registry to obtain a report from the trial Court with regard to the status of the civil suit in question. In compliance thereof, a report has been submitted by the Court of Special Judge, NDPS Cases, on 09.02.2026, stating therein that the suit filed by the plaintiff stood dismissed vide judgment and decree dated 22.11.2016.
2. In the present appeal, the appellant has laid challenge to the order dated 26.05.2006 passed by the learned District Judge, Hanumangarh, whereby the application preferred by the appellant under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC came to be rejected.
