Learned counsel for petitioner submits that in pursuance of notice dated 31.01.2014 (Annexure-3), petitioner has already stopped mining activities and surrendered the mining lease in the year 2014 itself. However, after a lapse of around 11 years, notice impugned dated 03.07.2025 (Annexure-5) has been issued against the petitioner for recovery of an amount of Rs.2,22,864/-.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner contends that the notice impugned is highly belated and the same has been issued without granting an opportunity of hearing to petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of writ petition to Mr. Lalit Pareek, DGC, who represents the respondents.
4. Hence, service is, therefore, complete.
5. Four weeks' time is granted to learned counsel for the respondents to file reply.
6. In the meantime, further proceedings of notice dated 03.07.2025 (Annexure-5) shall remain stayed.

7. It will be open for respondents to move appropriate application for vacation/modification of interim order, if so desire.
8. Registry is directed to reflect the name of Mr. Lalit Pareek, DGC as counsel for respondents in the cause list.
