1. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset, makes a limited submission that the respondent No.5-Nayab Tehsildar, Gyangarh, Tehsil Kareda, District Bhilwara, may be directed to consider and decide the representation to be filed by the petitioner by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law within a particular time period.
2. In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that the petitioner shall submit a detailed representation to the said respondent for ventilating his grievances within a period of 10

days from today. The representation of the petitioner shall be decided by such respondent No.5-Nayab Tehsildar, Gyangarh, Tehsil Kareda, District Bhilwara, by way of passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

3. It is made clear that this order shall not be construed as direction to the respondent-Authority to decide the application of the petitioner in any manner, but only in accordance with law.

4. With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition is disposed of.

5. Stay application and all pending application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
