1. The petitioners has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.02/2026 registered at Police Station Bhojasar, District Phalodi for offence under Sections 8/22 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the prosecution story, contraband weighing 4.48 grams of Mephedrone, which is below the commercial quantity, has been recovered from the joint possession of the Radheyshyam and Suresh. He further submits that the co-accused, Rajendra Kumar, has already been enlarged on bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 15.01.2026, and that the case of the present petitioners stands on similar footing to that of the said co-accused. Though three criminal antecedents have been registered against the petitioner, Radheyshyam, but only one

pertains to a case of similar nature. Likewise, one criminal antecedent of a similar nature is registered against the petitioner, Suresh, in which, he has already been enlarged on bail. Petitioners Radheyshyam and Suresh are in custody since 04.01.2026 and the trial of the case will take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in further custody and the bail application of the petitioners may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. are allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **Radheyshyam S/o Heera Ram** and **Suresh S/o Shiv Lal**, be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that each of them shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
