Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was suspended vide order dated 06.12.2024. Following the petitioner's suspension, the petitioner was directed to report to Headquarter, Jaipur, but he failed to do so as the petitioner was not well and submitted valid medical/fitness certificates to that effect. It is further submitted that multiple charge-sheets have been issued by the respondent(s) and the petitioner earlier

challenged the charge-sheet dated 17.07.2025 by way of filing writ petition S.B. Civil Writ Petition Nos.15575/2025, wherein vide interim order dated 28.08.2025 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, further proceedings in pursuance of charge-sheet dated 17.07.2025 were stayed. It is submitted that without considering the medical/fitness certificates filed by the petitioner, a third charge-sheet dated 24.11.2025 (Annex.7) has been issued against the petitioner regarding 27 day period of medical leave.

The matter requires consideration.

In view of the submissions made, **Issue notice**. Issue notice of stay application also.

Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due. Notices be made returnable within six weeks.

Meanwhile, further proceedings in pursuance of the charge-sheet dated 24.11.2025 (Annex.7), shall remain stayed.
