D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 8634/2023

1. We have gone through the contents of this petition as also the contents of D.B. Civil Writ Petition No.5091/2023. The similarity of the pleadings and the grounds leads to inference that the present petitioner Satya Narayan was in full know and notice of filing of D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 5091/2023, albeit at the instance of some other person. The other interesting feature of the case is that the present PIL petitioner had earlier filed a PIL on the same cause of action which was dismissed by this Court on 13.03.2023 in D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 9831/2021 Satyanarayan Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. True it is that, in this petition dismissal of earlier writ petition is mentioned, but we are of the clear view that second petition is not maintainable and if the petitioner had any grievance against the order passed on 13.03.2023, the course open was to challenge the order dated 13.03.2023 and not to repeat the petition.

2. In sum and substance, the petition is not only frivolous, but the bona-fides of the petitioner are also under serious dispute. In our view the petitioner does not appear to be a public spirited person but appears to be having some personal interest in the

matter. Therefore, without going into the merits of the case, we are inclined to dismiss the present Writ Petition.

3. Accordingly, the instant Writ Petition is dismissed with a cost of Rs.50,000/- payable to the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority.

D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 5091/2023

4. Dr. Sachin Acharya, learned Senior Counsel for the respondents submits that Babu Lal and Satya Narayan were acting hand in glove.

5. For the reasons which have been stated hereinabove, we find that even the petition filed by Babu Lal was not a bona-fide act but he was acting only on behalf of Satya Narayan. It is clear from the fact that the contents of this petition and the petition filed by Satya Narayan which was earlier dismissed by this Court are verbatim the same.

6. Therefore, we are inclined to dismiss this Writ petition also.

7. Accordingly, the instant Writ Petition is also dismissed with a cost of Rs.50,000/- payable to the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority.
