1. The present bail application has been filed by the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 against the order dated 16.01.2026 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Santhore, District Jalore in Bail Application No.43/2026 arising out of FIR No.122/2025, registered at Police Station Jhab, District Jalore for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 117(2) & 118(2) of BNS, 2023 by which the bail application of the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused-applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the allegation against the accused-applicant is that he assaulted the injured, Bhagirath and inflicted two injuries, i.e. one on the head by a sharp-edged weapon and

another by a blunt object. It is contended that although the injury on the head is alleged to have been caused by a sharp-edged weapon, but no such weapon has been recovered from the accused-applicant; however, only a wooden stick has been recovered from his possession. Learned counsel further submits that the injury sustained on the head of the injured has not been opined to be dangerous to life.

3. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant further contends that the accused-applicant was arrested on 12.01.2026 and has been in judicial custody since then. It is also submitted that the investigation is still in progress and the trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude. Therefore, it is prayed that the accused-applicant be enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor as well as learned counsel for the complainant vehemently oppose the bail application and submit that two other criminal cases are registered against the accused-applicant, therefore, accused-applicant should not be enlarged on bail.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, looking to the fact that the accused-applicant was arrested on 12.01.2026 and since then he is behind the bars and that the accused-applicant is aged about 65 years and that none of the injuries caused to the injured, has been opined to be dangerous to life; investigation is still in progress and trial will take long time to conclude, without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits

of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow the bail application filed by the applicant.

7. Consequently, this bail application filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 is allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicant **Kaluram S/o Shri Dhudaram**, arrested in connection with FIR No.122/2025, registered at Police Station Jhab, District Jalore shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

8. Applicant shall be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
