Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply stating that the claim of the petitioner has been decided vide order dated 09/11/2016. However, from perusal of the said order, it is clear that the said order is only sanction order, whereas, vide order dated 27/01/2016, a direction was issued to decide the claim of the petitioner in terms of the judgment rendered in the case of **Jawahar Lal Bohra vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.: 2014(3) WLC (Raj.) 647 & State of Rajasthan v. Mahesh Kumar Sharma : 2011(4) SCC 257**, but the same has not been done.

Accordingly, the matter is adjourned for four weeks to pass the appropriate direction in terms of the judgments referred above

and pass a speaking order in case, reimbursement is not being made in terms of the claim of the petitioner.
