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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE PRAMIL KUMAR MATHUR**

**Judgment / Order**

**23/02/2026**

1. The petitioners have preferred these bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.03/2026 registered at Police Station Ramdeora, District Jaisalmer, for offences under Sections 189(2), 329(4), 324(5) and 326(g) of BNS, 2023.
2. Since all these bail applications arise out of a common FIR, therefore, they are being decided by this common order.
3. Heard learned counsels for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor, and learned counsel for the complainant, and perused the material available on record.
4. Learned counsels for the petitioners submit that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. They further

submit that the allegations against the petitioners are of causing mischief by fire to the house of complainant and causing injuries. They contended that there are omnibus allegations against the present petitioners and no specific overt act has been assigned to them. They further submit that the petitioners, namely, Shankara Ram, Rawal Ram, Jagdish Ram @ Jagdish Prasad, Bhakhar Ram and Bhoja Ram, are behind the bars since 17.01.2026 and the other petitioners, Swaroopram and Bijalram are behind the bars since 21.01.2026. Though three criminal cases are registered against the petitioner Rawal Ram S/o Sh. Haru Ram, but he is bailed out in those cases. The trial of the case will take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in further custody and the bail application of the petitioners may be allowed.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor and counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail applications.

6. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.

7. Consequently, the bail applications under Section 483 B.N.S.S. are allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **Shankara Ram S/o Sh. Poona Ram, Rawal Ram S/o Sh. Haru Ram, Jagdish Ram @ Jagdish Prasad S/o Bagta Ram, Swaroopram S/o Dhanaram adopted S/o Naryanram, Bijalram S/o Ratanaram, Bhakhar Ram S/o Sh. Utma Ram and Bhoja Ram S/o Sh. Tara Ram** be released on bail provided

each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
