1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following reliefs:-

"I. the Respondents may kindly be directed to release and pay forthwith the entire unpaid/balance honorarium to the Petitioner for all teaching work actually performed by him under the Vidya Sambal Yojana during the academic session 2025-26, including the current semester, along with interest from the due date till the date of actual payment;

II. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing the Respondents to restore and ensure uninterrupted right of the Petitioner to mark attendance in the official attendance register and to ensure that his past attendance and teaching work is duly recorded, verified and certified, without any alteration or prejudice to his service record;

III. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing the Respondents to permit adjustment/extra classes to the Petitioner in available vacant periods, wherever classes could not be held due to holidays or institutional engagements, so as to enable completion of the



prescribed weekly workload, in furtherance of students' academic interest and the objectives of the Vidya Sambal Yojana;

IV. Direct the Respondents to extend to the Petitioner all statutory and service-related protections as available under the Rajasthan College Education Society (Hiring of Manpower) Rules, 2022/2023, and to ensure that no retaliatory, punitive or victimizing action is taken against him for having raised legitimate grievances; V. That In the interest of students, the respondents be directed to provide the petitioner with necessary basic academic and administrative facilities, and to pass a lawful order on the application classes. submitted regarding additional VI. Any other order of direction, which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case may kindly be passed in favour of the humble petitioner."

2. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset, makes a limited submission that the respondents may be directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law within a particular time period.

3. In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that the petitioner shall submit a detailed representation to the respondents for ventilating his grievances within a period of '10 days' from today. The representation of the petitioner shall be decided by respondent No.2- The Commissioner, College Education, Dr. S. Radhakrishnan Shiksha Sankul, Block-4, J.L.N. Marg, Jaipur, Rajasthan, by way of passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
