1. The petitioner has preferred this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.216/2025 registered at Police Station Nayasahar, District Bikaner for offence under Sections 137(2), 127(2), 49, 96, 64(1), 64(2)(m), 70(1) of BNS and Section 3/4, 16/17 of POCSO Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Public Prosecutor and counsel for the complainant and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He submits that petitioner is a lady aged about 35 years. He contended that allegation against the present petitioner is to provide mobile phone to the

victim on behalf of main accused Meghraj. Except that there is no allegation of sexual assault against the present petitioner. The petitioner is behind the bars since 15.12.2025, without any criminal past and the trial of the case will take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further custody and the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor and counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Madhu W/o Late Shri Madan**, be released on bail provided she furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that she shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
