1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in the present case, the impugned notice dated 14.01.2026 has been issued against the petitioner by the prescribed authority-cum-Sub-Divisional Officer, Nohar, District Hanumangarh in utter disregard of Section 13(1) of the Rajasthan Agricultural Credit Operations (Removal of Difficulties) Act, 1974 which mandates determination of the liability by such authorities at least three months prior to the date of issuance of such notice.
2. In that view of the matter, let notices be issued.
3. Mr. Aditya Singhi, learned counsel, who has entered caveat on behalf of respondent No.2 – Bank, accepts notice on its behalf.
4. Issue notice to respondent No.1 only.

5. Mr. Sanjay Raj Paliwal, learned G.C. is directed to accept notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Therefore, service is complete.

6. The Registry is directed to reflect the names of Mr. Sanjay Raj Paliwal, learned G.C. and Mr. Aditya Singhi in the cause-list as learned counsel for the respondents.

7. In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, the effect and operation of the notice dated 14.01.2026 (Annexure-8), issued by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Nohar, District Hanumangarh against the petitioner for recovery of Rs.17,06,740/-, shall remain stayed.

8. It is made clear that the present order shall not preclude the respondents from filing an application seeking vacation of the present order along with reply.
