1. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has cleared the Joint Entrance Test (JET) - 2025 for admission to undergraduate programme in Agriculture and Allied Sciences in Rajasthan and was allotted a seat for pursuing studies in B.Sc. Agriculture in respondent No.3 – College.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the information regarding such allotment of seat was not received by petitioner and, therefore, he could not appear before the College on due date.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that 10 seats are lying vacant in respondent No. 3 - College, however, admission has been denied to petitioner solely on the ground of delay in approaching respondent No. 3 – College.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

6. Meanwhile, if the seats are lying vacant, petitioner be considered for allotment against the said seat of B.Sc. Agriculture Course offered by respondent No.3- College provisionally. However, it is made clear that no equity shall be created in favour of petitioner by this interim order and his right to continue in the course shall remain subject to the final outcome of the present writ petition.
