1. The present bail application has been filed by the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 against the order dated 20.12.2025 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Phalodi, Rajasthan in connection with FIR No.101/2023, registered at Police Station Bhojasar, District Phalodi for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 427, 394/34 of the IPC, by which the bail application of the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 has been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused-applicant has been charged with offences punishable under Sections 341, 427 and 394/34 of the IPC. As per the prosecution story, four persons are alleged to have committed the offence of robbery out of whom one namely Manohar was caught on the spot, while the other accused persons namely Setharam, Patel Ram and the present accused-applicant absconded from the

spot. Learned counsel also argues that the charges levelled against the accused-applicant are triable by Judicial Magistrate. Learned counsel further submits that the similarly situated co-accused – Manohar and Patel Ram have already been enlarged on bail vide orders dated 06.12.2023 and 13.01.2026 respectively, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in SBCRLMB Nos. 14510/2023 and 308/2026. Learned counsel contends that the accused-applicant was arrested on 02.01.2025 and since then, he is behind the bars. It is further submitted that charge-sheet has been filed. Learned counsel prays that trial will take long time to conclude, therefore, the accused-applicant be enlarged on bail.

3. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the bail application and submits that some other cases have also been registered against the accused-applicant, therefore, he should not be enlarged on bail.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the facts that the charges levelled against the accused-applicant are triable by Judicial Magistrate; that the accused-applicant is behind the bars since 02.01.2025; that the charge-sheet has been filed and trial will take long time to conclude, but without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow the bail application filed by the accused-applicant.

6. Consequently, this bail application filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 is allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicant **Sawai Singh Alias Sawai Ram S/o Shri Hapuram** arrested in

FIR No.101/2023, registered at Police Station Bhojasar, District Phalodi shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes personal bond in the sum of Rs.**1,00,000/-** and two solvent **attested** sureties of Rs.**50,000/-** each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

7. The Accused-Applicant shall be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
