Order

24/02/2026

1. By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have prayed for the following reliefs:

"It is, therefore, humbly and respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed in view of the facts and circumstances stated hereinabove, and this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:

- 1. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction, particularly in the nature of Certiorari, quashing and setting aside the impugned order*

dated 20.01.2026 (Annexure-07) passed by the District Collector, Nagaur, whereby Village Dhani Maliyan has been retained in Ward No. 03 along with Gram Panchayat Jaswantabad.

2. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction directing the respondent authorities to restore Village Dhani Maliyan to Ward No. 04 within the territorial limits of Gram Panchayat Jasnagar, in accordance with the mandatory guidelines dated 17.12.2025 and office order dated 19.12.2025.

3. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction declaring the restructuring/delimitation carried out vide notification dated 30.09.2025, insofar as it relates to the village of the petitioners, as arbitrary, illegal, and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India.

4. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction directing the respondents to consider and decide the objections filed by the petitioners in a reasoned and lawful manner, strictly in accordance with Rule 4 of the Rajasthan Panchayati Raj (Election) Rules, 1994.

5. Grant any other relief which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, in favour of the petitioners.

6. Award costs of the present writ petition in favour of the petitioners."

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied if the District Collector, Nagaur, is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners seeking restoration of the names of villagers of Village Dhani Maliyan, District Nagaur, in the voters list of Ward No. 04 of Panchayat Samiti, Riyanbari, Nagaur.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the limited prayer made, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh representation along with a certified copy of this order before the office of the District Collector, Nagaur.

4. In the event such representation is filed, the District Collector, Nagaur, shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably before issuance of the final voter list.

5. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued solely with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of the petitioners' grievances, and the same

shall not be construed as a direction to decide the representation in a particular manner.

6. The stay petition and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
