Counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier upon application of the petitioner re-conciliation was undertaken and the wife did not raise grievance regarding any such abuse but as the re-conciliation failed, the present FIR has been lodged.

This Court is not inclined to grant any indulgence in the matter.

After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press this misc. petition, however, seeks liberty of limited protection for a period of 15 days and to submit representation before the I.O.

In view of the above submission, the misc. petition as well as stay application are dismissed as not pressed. However, the petitioner is permitted to submit a representation alongwith all relevant documents before the I.O. within a period of 07 days and the Investigating Officer is directed to consider the documents in an objective manner before forming any opinion.

In the meanwhile for a period of 15 days, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.7/2026 registered at Police Station, Bhojasar, District Phalodi. However, the petitioner shall be required to join investigation.
