1. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.5 preferred a suit for permanent injunction before the learned trial Court and as per the averments made in the plaint, the water supply to the petitioner's agricultural field was described as absolutely illegal.

2. He further submits that upon receiving information regarding the said plaint, the petitioner moved an application under Order 1

Rule 10 CPC seeking impleadment, however, the same was rejected by the learned trial Court vide order dated 16.01.2026, observing that since no stay had been granted, no adverse effect had been caused to the petitioner at this stage.

3. He also submits that although no interim stay was granted, if the suit is finally decided, the rights of the petitioner would be adversely affected.

4. The matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice of the writ petition as well as the stay application to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.

6. In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, further proceedings in Civil Suit No. 179/2025, titled as "*Vikram Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.*", pending before the learned Civil Judge, Hanumangarh, shall remain stayed.
