1. Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a limited submission that the petitioner Institution has preferred an application before the respondents for the purpose of grant of NOC for enhancement of seats upto 60 seats in B.Sc. Nursing Course for academic session 2025-26. He submits that till date, the respondents have

not processed the applications filed by the petitioner dated 27.07.2024, 04.11.2024 & 08.03.2025 (Annex.10, 12). He submits that the respondents may be directed to decide the said applications in a time bound manner, as in case of non-grant of NOC with enhanced seats, the petitioner-Institution would be deprived for said seats in the aforesaid course. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that in spite of earlier orders passed by this Court, the applications of petitioners have not been finally decided yet.

2. Thus, in view of the limited submissions made, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to decide the applications dated 27.07.2024, 04.11.2024 & 08.03.2025 filed by the petitioner – Institution (Annex.10, 12) for the purpose of grant of NOC for the B.Sc. Nursing Course for 60 seats, strictly in accordance with law after taking into consideration all the requisites required to be fulfilled by the petitioner - Institution within a period of '30 days' from the date of receipt of the said order.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as any other pending application, if any, also stand disposed of.

4. It is made clear that this order does not indicate the application of the petitioner be decided in a particular manner. The respondents are required to examine the documents and decide strictly in accordance with law.
