1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the respondent-Panchayati Raj Department published a tender notice No. 01/2025-26 dated 24.12.2025 for procurement of raw material used for construction of roads for Gram Panchayat. In response thereto, the petitioner submitted its bid. It is the case of the petitioner that the respondents after opening the bid, cancelled the entire tender process on the ground that only one bid had been received and therefore, in order to ensure

competitive bidding, a fresh tender process was proposed to be initiated.

2. Learned counsel submitted that act and action of the respondents in the present case are not supported by any terms or conditions reflected in the tender notice/form issued by the respondents.

3. The matter requires consideration.

4. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application as well.

5. Mr. Kuldeep Vaishnav, AGC who usually appears before this Court on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 3 is directed to accept notice. Service of notice upon respondent No. 1 to 3 is therefore, complete.

6. Service of notice upon respondent No. 4 is dispensed for the time being.

7. Mr. Kuldeep Vaishnav, AGC prays for and is granted three weeks' time to file reply to the instant writ petition.

8. In the meanwhile and till next date of hearing, the respondents may continue with the fresh tender process, however, the same shall not be finalized without prior permission of this court.

9. Registry is directed to reflect the name of Mr. Kuldeep Vaishnav, AGC in the cause-list.

10. The present order shall not preclude the respondents from filing an application seeking vacation of present order along with reply.
