The instant misc petition under Section 528 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.15/2026 PS Ambapura District Banswara for offences under Sections 85, 120(1), 318(4) BNS.

On the same set of facts, earlier an FIR under Section 498A IPC was registered against the petitioner wherein, the petitioner has been duly acquitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners while not pressing the instant criminal misc. petition on merits, seeks liberty for the

petitioners to submit a detailed representation to the concerned Superintendent of Police raising all the contentions raised in the present petition.

Accordingly, the instant criminal misc. petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to submit a detailed representation to the concerned Superintendent of Police averring therein all the grounds which have been raised in this petition within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

In the event, the representation is submitted, the concerned Superintendent of Police is directed to minutely and objectively consider the contents of the same and thereafter, issue necessary instructions to the Investigating Officer within 30 days. All the relevant documents with the representation shall also be taken into consideration.

Till 30 days from the date of filing of representation, the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.15/2026, registered at the Police Station Ambapura, District Banswara.

The petitioners would be free to avail appropriate legal remedy in accordance with law, if occasion so arises.

Stay application and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
