1. By way of filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

"It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

a) That to issue a writ of mandamus commanding the respondents authority to issue direction/instructions to retrieve/restore/De-freeze the account of the petitioner, bearing account number 42761620903

B) That to issue a writ of mandamus commanding the respondents authority to give explanation why the account of the petitioner bearing no 42761620903 was freeze by the bank.

C) Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deems just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may kindly be issued.

D) The petitioner pray to only freeze the disputed amount."

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to submit a representation before respondent No.1 –

Branch Manager of the State Bank of India, Aau, District Phalodi, for redressal of his grievances.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before respondent No.1 – Branch Manager of the State Bank of India, Aau, District Phalodi, who shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt thereof.

4. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the petitioner's representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of his grievances, and the same shall not be construed as a direction to decide the representation in any particular manner.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition as well as the stay application stand disposed of.
