1. The present bail application has been filed by the accused-applicants under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 against the order dated 04.02.2026 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge No.1, Nagaur, District Nagaur in Bail Application No.101/2026 arising out of FIR No.150/2025, registered at Police

Station Khinvsar, District Nagaur for the offences punishable under Sections 189(2), 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 118(2) and 324(4) of BNS, 2023 by which the bail application of the accused-applicants under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicants submits that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that all the accused-applicants belong to the same family and have a land dispute with the complainant party. It is also submitted that the alleged incident occurred in July 2025, and the accused-applicants were arrested on 29.01.2026 and have been in custody since then. Learned counsel further submits that only one grievous injury caused by a sharp-edged weapon was found on the foot of the injured, Nema Ram, and none of the injuries sustained by any of the injured persons has been opined to be dangerous to life.

3. Learned counsel for the accused-applicants contends that the accused-applicants were arrested on 29.01.2026 and have been in judicial custody since then. It is further contended that the investigation and the trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude; therefore, the accused-applicants may be granted the benefit of bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, looking to the period of custody of the accused-applicants; the fact that some land disputes between the parties are pending adjudication; accused-applicants were arrested on 29.01.2026 and

trial will take long time to conclude, without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow the bail application filed by the applicants.

7. Consequently, this bail application filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 is allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicants **(1) Mangi Lal S/o Shri Idan Ram Jat, (2) Dinesh S/o Shri Mangi Lal Jat, (3) Ramsawroop S/o Shri Mangi Lal Jat, (4) Budha Ram S/o Shri Durga Ram Jat & (5) Manoj @ Manohar Ram S/o Shri Durga Ram Jat**, arrested in connection with FIR No.150/2025, registered at Police Station Khinvsar, District Nagaur shall be released on bail; provided each of them furnishes personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Applicants shall be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
