1. This Court on the larger grievance that has been raised by the members of the Bar along with some specific lawyers that despite the Court dates, the matters are not being listed, thought it appropriate to intervene while considering it to be interference in the administration of justice, more particularly, when the issue involved was of bail applications. The operating portion of the order dated 22.02.2024 reads as follows:-

Let a notice of contempt be issued to Superintendent/In-charge of the Cause-list Section and Administrative Officer Judicial, Criminal Section as to why proceedings of contempt be not initiated against them and any other officials, if found to be negligent and derelicting towards their duties.

2. Mr. Rajesh Joshi, learned Senior Advocate assisted by Mr. Mahaveer Singh have taken this Court to the reply in which, the

concerned respondent No.1 has rendered unconditional apology and has also pointed out certain practical issues which includes the computer server, network and also transmission of record pertaining to files which are having a shorter date and requires adherence, in accordance with the direction of the Court.

3. Mr. Tribhuvan Gupta, learned counsel has also filed the reply in which he has rendered unconditional apology and has explained the issues involved which are similar to the issues raised by respondent No.1.

4. Since the notice is of contempt and carries vide significance and ramification, therefore, it will be appropriate that a affidavit/ reply be filed by the registry of the High Court through the Registrar (Judicial), who is the over all in-charge of the affairs involved.

5. Such affidavit be filed before the next date of hearing.

6. A copy of this order shall be given by the Court Master to Registrar (Judicial) to enable the office of the Registrar (Judicial) to file their response/ report/ stand of the High Court in pursuance of the order dated 22.02.2024.
