The present misc. Application has been preferred by the applicant for clarification / modification of the order dated 12.01.2026 passed by this Court in D.B. Special Appeal Writ No.1866/2025.

Mr. Manoj Bhandari, learned Senior Advocate, assisted by Mr. Aniket Tater, appearing for the applicant, submits that the appeal was disposed of while the effect and operation of the order dated 28.11.2025 qua the appellant was to remain stayed till the next date of hearing. Learned counsel further submits that the respondents have created two classes; one who continued and another who discontinued and are maintaining the same by continuing those persons who are continuing and discontinuing the persons who have discontinued

Since the matter is likely to be decided by the learned Single Bench of this Court, no further modification or clarification is required. The impugned order dated 12.01.2026 is itself clear that the applicant is to be treated similarly in pursuance of the stay upon the order dated 28.11.2025, until the learned Single Bench further adjudicates and decides the fate of the said interim order.

In view of above, the present misc. Application is dismissed.
