1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.64/2026 registered at Police Station Pratapnagar, District Udaipur for offence under Sections 318(4) of BNS.
2. Heard Mr. Karan Singh (father of the petitioner) appears for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. Government Advocate and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 38 years old lady who has falsely been implicated in this case. He also submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that she solemnized marriage of co-accused Kumkum with the son of the complainant and after some time Kumkum ran away thereby cheated him. He again submits that co-accused Kumkum has got the benefit of bail by the trial Court itself on

05.02.2026. The case of the petitioner is on better footing. He again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 31.01.2026 without any criminal past. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required, hence the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Smt. Puspadevi W/o Sh. Nitin Kumar**, be released on bail provided she furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that she shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
