1. This application has been filed by the petitioner seeking extension of time for depositing 10% of the fine amount as ordered by this Court.
2. This Court, vide order dated 18.07.2025, disposed of the criminal misc. petition preferred by the petitioner with a direction to deposit 10% of the cheque amount instead of 20% as ordered by the trial court as a condition precedent to suspension of sentence pending appeal, within a period of one month.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to *bonafide* error on the part of the local counsel of the petitioner, the certified copy of the order dated 18.07.2025 could not be produced before the trial court and therefore, an arrest warrant has now been issued against the petitioner. Learned counsel thus prayed that period of depositing 10% amount of the cheque amount may be extended.

4. Considering the submissions made at bar and the above factual situation, the instant application seeking extension of time to deposit the said amount is allowed.

5. The period of depositing 10% of the cheque amount as ordered by this Court, granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order 18.07.2025 is extended upto 10.03.2026. The petitioner is directed to deposit 10% of the cheque amount by 10.03.2026. It is made clear that no further time extension shall be granted to the applicant-petitioner.
