Learned counsel for the petitioner-firm submitted that in the month of August, 2025, the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Bhilwara issued a tender for providing unskilled labour for sanitation work in the city. Pursuant to the said tender, the petitioner-firm submitted its bid and was declared successful. However, a show cause notice was issued to the petitioner alleging that it had submitted a forged experience certificate along with the tender form. The petitioner-firm submitted its reply denying the allegations. Upon consideration of the reply, the matter was examined and the petitioner-firm was found eligible for award of

the work. Consequently, a work order dated 04.09.2025 was issued in its favour.

Learned counsel further submitted that, to the utter disbelief and surprise of the petitioner-firm, the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Bhilwara, vide order dated 03.02.2026, cancelled the work order dated 04.09.2025 and also imposed a penalty upon it on the ground that it had annexed a forged experience certificate with the tender form.

It was contended that the reasons assigned for cancellation of the work order in the order dated 03.02.2026 are not tenable in the eyes of law, inasmuch as the alleged forged experience certificate was not annexed by the petitioner-firm with the tender form submitted pursuant to the tender notice issued in August, 2025. It was further submitted that the said issue had already been inquired into by the municipal authorities pursuant to the show cause notice dated 15.10.2025, and after considering the reply submitted by the petitioner-firm, it was found eligible and the work order was accordingly issued in its favour.

The matter requires consideration.

Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application as well.

Shri Rajesh Panwar, AAG, who usually appears before this Court on behalf of the respondents, is directed to accept notice in the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply two sets of the paper book in the office of Shri Rajesh Panwar, AAG, within the next two weeks.

Registry is directed to reflect the name of Shri Monal Chugh, Associate to Shri Rajesh Panwar, AAG, as learned counsel for the respondents in the cause list.

In the meanwhile and until further orders, the effect and operation of the order dated 03.02.2026 cancelling the work order dated 04.09.2025 issued in favour of the petitioner shall remain stayed.
