1. The petitioner has filed this interim bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.70/2025 registered at Police Station Begun, District Chittorgarh for offence under Sections 8/18, 25 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is in judicial custody in connection with the aforesaid case. It is contended that the wife of the applicant is suffering from uterus problem and as per medical report obtained from concerned Police Station, she requires constant care and emotional support, which can be provided only by the applicant. Relevant medical documents have been placed on record. It is further submitted that the applicant undertakes to surrender immediately after

expiry of the interim bail period and shall not misuse the liberty so granted.

4. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer; however, he does not dispute the pregnancy of the applicant's wife.

5. Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the material available on record, this Court is of the view that petitioner's wife is suffering from uterus problem and the presence of the applicant is required for her care and well-being. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to grant interim bail to the applicant for a limited period.

6. Accordingly, the interim bail application is allowed. The applicant Bherulal S/o Chunilal Rebari, is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of 7 days from the date of his release, in connection with aforesaid FIR on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court / Jail Authority, subject to the condition that the applicant shall surrender before the concerned jail authorities immediately upon expiry of the interim bail period of 7 days, unless the period is extended by a competent court.

7. It is made clear that if the applicant fails to surrender after the expiry of the interim bail period, the authorities shall be at liberty to proceed against him in accordance with law.

8. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
