1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.538/2025 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Gfor offence under Sections 8/ 21 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that 82.56 gram heroin was recovered from the conscious possession of co-accused Vipin Kumar, which is below commercial quantity. He further argued that the co-accused Vipin Kumar has already been enlarged on bail on 20.01.2026. The allegation against the petitioner is that he is the supplier of the above contraband. He again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 29.01.2026 with one antecedent of similar nature in which he is bailed out. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no

further custodial interrogation is required, hence on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner especially on the ground of parity but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Pradeep Thakur S/o Mool Chand Thakur**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
