The instant criminal misc. petition has been preferred under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing of FIR No.34/2026 registered at Police Station Ambamata, District Udaipur for the alleged offences under Sections 316(2) and 318(4) of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present FIR has been registered regarding a contract entered between the parties for providing service at an event. It is contended that the dispute is purely contractual in nature and the FIR has been registered merely as a recovery proceeding under the garb of criminal prosecution

This Court has considered the matter and is inclined to interfere.



Issue Notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Issue notice to the respondent No.2, returnable within a period of three weeks.

In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.34/2026, registered at Police Station Ambamata, District Udaipur. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation.
