1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by order dated 29.01.2026 passed in the case of Dr. Naveen Kumar Bheel & Ors. Vs. The State of Rajasthan & Ors.: S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.2114/2026, wherein the Coordinate Bench of this Court

disposed of the said writ petition with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners and other person if any in the vacant post of Medical Officer on Urgent Temporary Basis.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents is not in a position to refute the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case is squarely covered by Dr. Naveen Kumar Bheel (supra).

3. For ready reference, the operative paragraph in the case of Dr. Naveen Kumar Bheel (supra), is reproduced hereunder:

“In the above factual facts and circumstances of the case and contentions of the parties, the writ petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners and other persons if any in the vacant post of Medical Officer on Urgent Temporary Basis, their services are required to be considered subject to same terms and conditions and the said consideration shall be based on period of experience and merit.”

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is also disposed of with similar directions as given in the case of Dr. Naveen Kumar Bheel (supra). The respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner in the vacant post of Medical Officer on Urgent Temporary Basis, his services are required to be considered subject to same terms and conditions and the said consideration shall be based on period of experience and merit.
