After arguing to some extent, learned counsel for the petitioner made a prayer that instead of deciding the writ petition on merits the respondent-Department may be directed to decide the petitioner's representation (Annexure-6), pending before it, in accordance with the prevailing rules and guidelines within a fixed time period.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Department does not dispute the above proposition.
3. The prayer seems to be genuine.

4. In this view of the matter, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to the respondent-Department to consider the pending representation (Annexure-6) of the petitioners objectively and decide the same by a speaking order within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Needless to say that the petitioner is not precluded from approaching this Court again in case his grievance would persist.

6. With these observations and directions, the writ petition as well as stay petition are disposed of.
