1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.459/2025 registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sri Ganganagar for offence under Sections 8/21, 29 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that he has supplied 51 gram heroin to the prime accused Amar Singh and Prem Singh from whose possession above contraband was recovered, which is below commercial quantity. The co-accused Amar Singh and Prem Singh has been granted benefit of bail on 16.10.2025. The case of petitioner is on better footing than to the co-accused. He again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 21.01.2026

with four antecedents, out of which two cases of similar nature in which one case has been decided and in rest cases, he is on bail. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required, hence on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner especially on the ground of parity, but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Lakhvinder Singh @ Lakhu S/o Shri Surjeet Singh Rai Sikh**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
