1. The present bail application has been filed by the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 against the order dated 07.02.2026 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Special Court, P.C. Act cases, Pali in connection with FIR No.329/2025, registered at Police Station CPS ACB Jaipur, District ACB Pali-II for the offences punishable under Section 7 of the P.C. Act, by which the bail application of the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 has been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused-applicant has falsely been implicated in this matter. Learned counsel argues that the allegation against the accused-applicant is that he demanded and accepted bribe from the complainant, Ajaypal Singh. The allegation against the accused-applicant is under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act. Learned counsel contends that the accused-applicant was arrested on 12.12.2025 and since then, he is behind the bars. The charge-

sheet has been filed. Learned counsel prays that trial will take long time to conclude, therefore, the accused-applicant be enlarged on bail.

3. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the bail application.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

5. Having regard to the considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and further considering that the accused-applicant is behind the bars since 12.12.2025; that the charge-sheet has been filed and trial will take long time to conclude, but without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow the bail application filed by the accused-applicant.

6. Consequently, this bail application filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 is allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicant **Bhaga Ram S/o Mangi Lal** arrested in FIR No.329/2025, registered at Police Station CPS ACB Jaipur, District ACB Pali-II shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes personal bond in the sum of Rs.**1,00,000/-** and two solvent **attested** sureties of Rs.**50,000/-** each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

7. The Accused-Applicant shall be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
