1. The writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following reliefs:-

"A. By an appropriate writ order or direction, the Order Dated 10.01.2026 (Annex-3), the order dated 02.02.2026 (Annex-7) passed by Rajasthan Civil Services: Appellate Tribunal, Jodhpur Bench and any Relieving Order may kindly be quashed and set aside qua the petitioner.

B. By an appropriate writ, order or direction. the respondents may kindly be directed to not to relieve the petitioner from his present posting place at Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Soorsagar, Jodhpur.

C. By appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to permit the petitioner to work continue as School Lecturer (History) at Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Soorsagar, Jodhpur with all consequential benefits.

D. Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner."

2. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset, makes a limited submission that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents may be directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law within a particular time period.

3. In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that the petitioner shall submit a detailed representation to the respondents for ventilating his grievances within a period of '7 days' from today. The representation of the petitioner shall be decided by such respondent by way of passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'two weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
