Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of the allegation of causing financial loss to the Rajasthan Cooperative Dairy Federation, FIR No.314/2025 was lodged on 01.10.2025, in which, petitioner is the prime accused. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on identically same allegations, respondents have now served one charge-sheet dated 16.01.2026. The petition and the contents of the FIR as also the

charge-sheet would reveal that for the same allegations, criminal proceedings as well as disciplinary proceedings are being conducted parallelly. It is submitted that as the charges levelled in the FIR and charge-sheet are similar in nature, therefore, in case, the petitioner discloses his defence pursuant to the charge-sheet issued to the petitioner in disciplinary proceedings, it would cause serious prejudice and miscarriage of justice to the petitioner during the criminal trial. Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Capt. M Paul Anthony vs. Bharat Gold Mines Ltd. & Anr. reported in (1999) 3 SCC 679.**

The matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to the respondents.

In the meanwhile and till further orders, further proceedings pursuant to the departmental charge-sheet dated 16.01.2026 shall remain stayed.

List the matter after four weeks.
