1. By way of filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

"It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:

i. That by an appropriate writ, order and direction, direct the respondent bank to unfreeze the petitioners account, bearing IndusInd Bank, Sriganaganagar bearing account number 201001263405, IFSC-INDB0000855 By an appropriate writ, order and direction, direct the respondent bank to pay damages and compensation for mentally and economic loss.

ii. Any other appropriate order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deems just and proper may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Review Committee constituted by the Managing Director of Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd. to consider and decide the petitioner's grievances against VCR No. 6635 dated 24.08.2024 as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of production of a certified copy of this order before the office of the Superintending Engineer (Vigilance) of Jodhpur Discom, Jodhpur, through the Assistant Engineer (Vigilance), Jodhpur Discom, Sadulshahar, District Churu.
3. It is made clear that, if deemed necessary, the Review Committee constituted by the Managing Director of Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd. shall also afford an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner before deciding his grievances in relation to VCR No. 6635 dated 24.08.2024.
4. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition as well as the stay application stand disposed of.
