1. The instant criminal misc. petition under Section 482 Cr.P.c. (528 of BNSS) has been filed by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.0191/2022 dated 03.07.2022 registered at Police Station Khairwada, District Udaipur, and all consequential proceedings for offences under Section 384 of IPC on the basis of compromise entered between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and it is borne out from the compromise (affidavit) dated 02.05.2025 (Annex.2), that the respondent No.2-complainant is not inclined to proceed further in the matter. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance on the decision of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the case of ***Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. [(2012) 10 SCC 303]*** and urges, that in these circumstances, the impugned FIR

and all consequential proceedings may be quashed on the basis of the compromise.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2-complainant concurs the factum of compromise and submits that in view of the compromise, the respondent No.2-complainant does not want to proceed further in the matter.

4. In view of compromise arrived at between the parties and applying the ratio in the decision of **Gian Singh (Supra)**, This Court deems it just and proper to invoke inherent powers of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C (528 of BNSS).

5. Accordingly, the present misc. petition is allowed. The FIR No.0191/2022 dated 03.07.2022 registered at Police Station Khairwada, District Udaipur, and all consequential proceedings for offences under Section 384 of IPC lodged against the petitioner, are hereby quashed and set aside on the basis of the above compromise deed.

6. Stay application also disposed.
