1. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated candidates have preferred D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No.1863/2025 and other connected appeals tiled as "Roshan Patidar & Ors. v. State of Rajasthan & Ors." against the order dated 08.12.2025 passed in S.B.C.W.P. No.23632/2025 titled as "Himanshu Joshi & Ors. v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.", He submits that the said special appeal was filed aggrieved by the refusal to grant ad-interim protection by the learned Single Bench to the appellants against the order dated 28.11.2025, whereby the petitioners were removed from service.

2. Learned Counsel further submits that the Hon'ble Division Bench has disposed of the said appeal (S.A.W. No.1863/2025) while granting interim protection to the appellants therein, staying the impugned order dated 28.11.2025, whereby their services were terminated, till the next date of hearing before the learned Single Bench.

3. The relevant paragraphs of the order dated 12.01.2026 passed by Hon'ble Division Bench, being apposite, are reproduced hereunder:

"5. This Court finds that when the impugned order is common and interim protection has already been granted by learned Single Bench at Jaipur, the principle of parity, consistency and fairness requires that similar interim protection ought to operate in present matter also.

6. In view of the above facts, the present appeals are disposed of with a direction that the order dated 28.11.2025, qua the petitioners/appellants shall remain stayed till next date of hearing before the learned Single Bench.

7. It is made clear that passing of this order shall not prejudice the case of either of the parties before the learned Single Judge with regard to the jurisdiction of writ. It is further made clear that the respondents shall be at liberty to seek vacation of the interim order from the learned Single Bench itself."

4. In view of the above, issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of the stay application also.

5. In the meanwhile and until the next date of hearing, effect and operation of the termination order dated 07.01.2026 (Annex.3), qua the petitioner shall remain stayed.
