1. Petitioner filed the instant writ petition seeking a direction to
post/transfer the petitioner at a nearby place of her residence on
the vacant post of Teacher Grade-III (Level-I), in the Tehsil
Rajgarh, district Churu.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is sanguine that, in case she is allowed to file a
representation qua the grievance raised in the instant writ petition

and the same is taken up on the administrative side, it will receive favorable treatment.

3. In view of the aforesaid submission, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of. In case the petitioner files a representation, the competent authority is directed to decide the same objectively, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law, keeping in view the transfer policy/guideline of the State Government.

4. It is made clear that the direction to consider the representation shall not be construed as an expression of any opinion on the merits of the matter.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
