1. The case has been listed by the Registry in view of the order passed by this Court on 25.02.2026 whereby this Court directed that the case be listed on 26.02.2026 to verify whether the payment has been made or not.
2. Learned counsel submits that the amount of Rs.3,00,000/- was paid as full and final payment/settlement of the money decree including the accrued interest and that the decree stands satisfied in terms of the settlement arrived at and recorded by the Court on 25.02.2026.
