1. The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner seeking the following reliefs:-

“It is, therefore, humbly and respectfully prayed that this writ petition of the petitioner may kindly be allowed and record of the case may kindly be called for:-

1. By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to modify the alignment of the 220KV transmission line by changing Pole Number 14/2 as AP-15 and connecting it straightly to AP-16, thereby establishing poles number 15/2 and 15/3 at the corner of the petitioner's land instead of the middle portion.

2. By an appropriate writ, order, or direction, the respondent authorities may be directed to reconsider and decide the representation dated 04.02.2026 (Annex-3) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, principles of natural justice, and after taking into account the alternative alignment proposed by the petitioner

3. Any other appropriate writ, order, or direction that this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.
4. Costs of the writ petition may kindly be awarded to the petitioner."

2 After arguing the matter for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if the competent authority of the respondent department is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner seeking modification of the alignment of 220 KV transmission line by changing Pole Number 14/2 as AP-15 and connecting its straightly to AP-16, thereby establishing poles number 15/2 and 15/3 at the corner of the petitioner's land instead of middle portion.

3 In view of the aforesaid, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with the direction to the petitioner to file a fresh writ petition along with certified copy of the order within a period of ten days from today before competent authority of the respondent department. In case, a representation is so made, then the competent authority of respondent department shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible. It is made clear that aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of the petitioner's grievance and same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.

Stay application also stands disposed of.
