The present criminal misc. petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing of FIR No.13/2026, registered at Police Station Panchaudi, District Nagaur for offences under Sections 329(4), 303(2) and 3(5) of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners and the complainant are real brothers and the same is not disputed. The dispute raised between the parties in the present case pertains to the possession of property alleged by the petitioners to be ancestral.

Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to call for the factual report on the next date of hearing.

In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.13/2026, registered at Police Station Panchaudi, District Nagaur. However, the petitioners shall join investigation.
