1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks limited indulgence of this Court for issuance of directions to learned District Collector, Nagaur, to decide the representation of petitioner for opening of the public way by removing encroachment thereon. Learned counsel for the petitioner referred to communication dated 14.08.2024 (Annex.7) issued by District Collector, Nagaur himself to Deputy Secretary to the Government, Revenue (Group-6) Department, wherein necessary instructions were sought for removal of encroachment

from public way. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the same, no effective action has been taken by respondent authority.

2. Looking to the factual matrix of present case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct petitioner to file a fresh representation before District Collector, Nagaur, within a period of 15 days from today. In case such representation is filed, the same shall be decided by District Collector, Nagaur, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of said representation, strictly in accordance with law. It is further directed that the same shall be decided by passing a speaking order after granting opportunity of hearing to petitioner.

3. With these observations, present writ petition is hereby disposed of.

4. Stay application and all pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
